- To compare other's thinking on what is important to us -snowflake discussion of our differences and similarities **agreeing to disagree** repeated shows movement of PD
- Lingo Bingo **vocabulary** part of lesson language focus.
- Immersion in text: separate text into 5 segments, tell each segment, children draw, children re tell story from their pictures.

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
